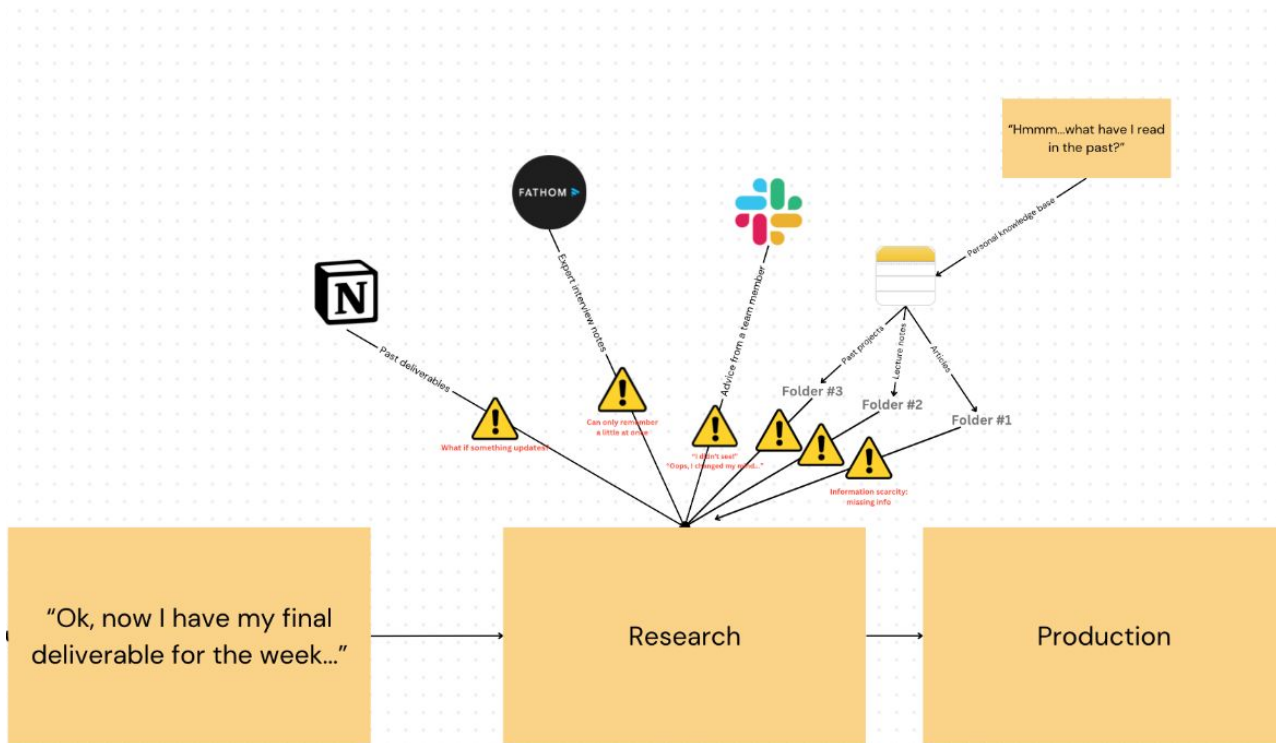
Create a unified integrated interface

Good if you don't want to migrate to new tools, just need an easier way to keep track of existing tools



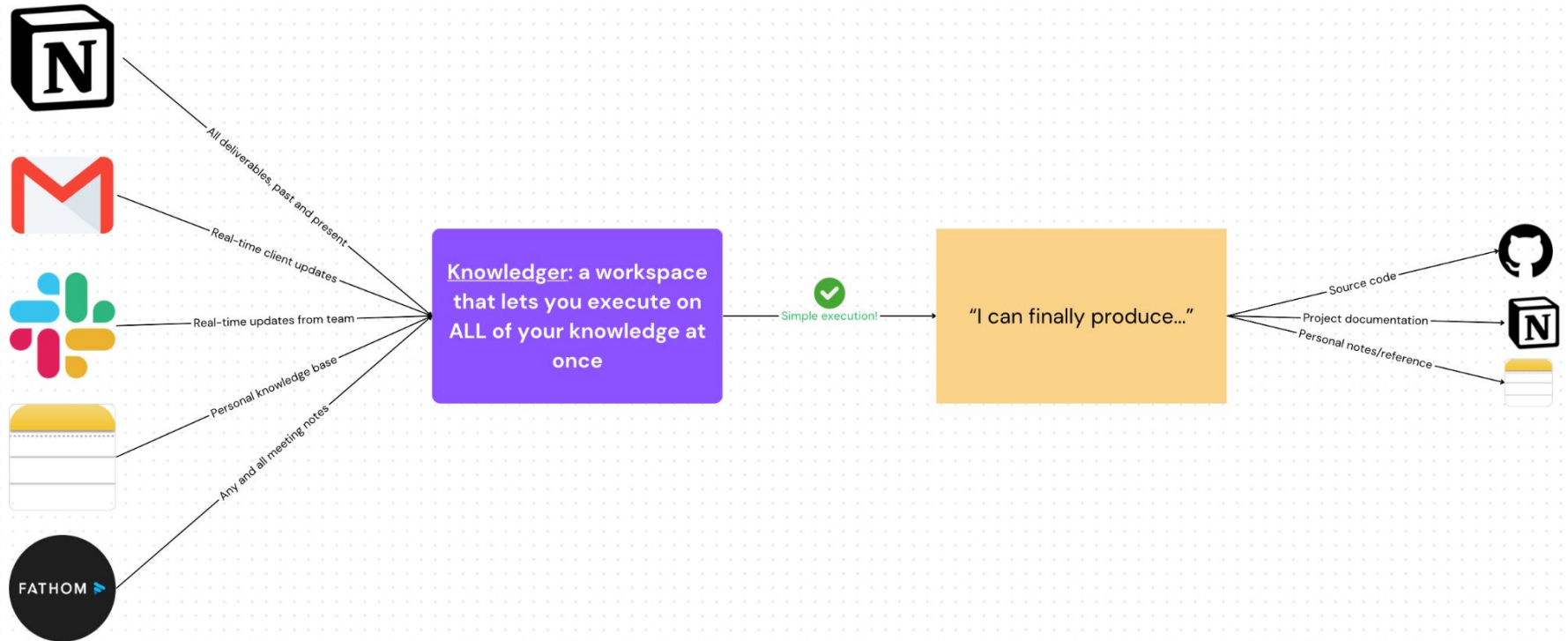

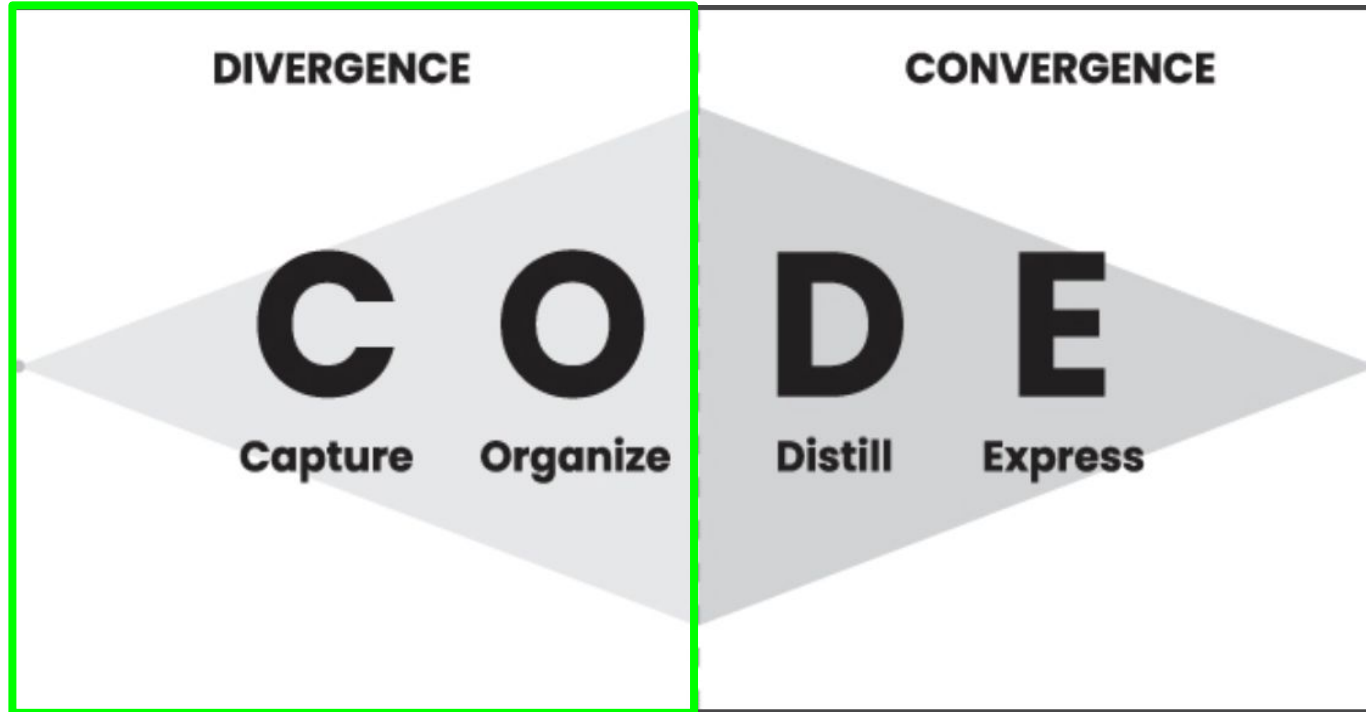
